Brand new possibilities with Color

We've all encountered a situation where cleaning would not remove a stain, whether from added color or color loss. Would making a permanent improvement be of value to the carpet owner? Sure it would!

Using a liquid dye can be time-consuming and leave a result not much better looking than the stain. Would you be interested in learning a method that allows better color correction, and in so little time that spot dyeing can be profitable? We think so!

Tony Wheelwright will demonstrate:

- The use of solid color dyes
- Which dyes work best given the situation
- How to easily match colors
- Easy removal of colors to start over
- How to set the dyes to give them permanence

Tony has gone through carpet mill training where they use this "lost art" and learned how they make quick and easy color repairs to new carpeting.

Bring a piece of carpet to this class, with the most challenging stains you can think of, and get hands-on practice. Within a very short time you'll be able to make spot color repair a profitable part of your service package.

Note: Tony gave a brief of this presentation at a CCINW meeting. Within minutes after the presentation, attendees that knew they couldn't do color repair were doing remarkably good work repairing color.
