

BLOODBORNE PATHOGEN TRAINING

OSHA 29 CFR 1910.1030/WAC 296-823-12005

If you or your employees ever encounter any bodily fluids, you and they are in danger of contracting a variety of diseases, with some like AIDS and hepatitis being debilitating or deadly.

For you, this course is required by law.

This OSHA and WISHA approved course provides the information needed to meet and exceed the guidelines for handling bodily fluids safely. In addition, the forms required for record keeping, appropriate personal protective equipment and vaccines will be supplied.

A few points of the law:

- Make sure all employees with occupational exposure participate in a training program that is provided at no cost to them, and conducted during working hours
- Provide training annually before assigning tasks where occupational exposure may occur
- Make sure the person conducting the required training is knowledgeable about the subject matter as it relates to your workplace
- Make sure the training program contains at least a general explanation of epidemiology, pathogen transmission, exposure, protective gear, vaccinations...
- Have a written exposure control plan

The course must include an opportunity for interactive questions and answers with the trainer at the time of the training session.

All of these and much more will be included in this fast-paced course.
